



Information clause for participants in the competition “DINOSAURS. Still alive?”

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

1. The controller of the personal data is the Polish Geological Institute - National Research Institute based in Warsaw at ul. Rakowiecka 4, 00-075 Warsaw, phone: (+48) 22 45 92 000, e-mail: biuro@pgi.gov.pl.
2. The PGI-NRI has appointed a Data Protection Officer whom you can contact in matters concerning the protection and processing of your personal data at the following email address: iod@pgi.gov.pl or in writing to the registered office of the PGI-NRI: ul. Rakowiecka 4, 00-975 Warszawa
3. Your personal data is processed for the purpose of the competition "DINOSAURS. Still alive?", organised by the Polish Geological Institute - National Research Institute based in Warsaw at ul. Rakowiecka 4, 00-075 Warsaw on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR - consent of the data subject and Article 6(1)(f) - legitimate interest of the Controller to store, for archiving purposes.
4. The recipients of the data are entities with which the Controller has signed a contract of entrustment for the processing of personal data and entities to which the data will be made available within the framework of legal obligations.
5. Data will not be transferred to third countries/international organisations (outside the EEA).
6. You have the right to request from the Controller access to your personal data, rectification, erasure or restriction of processing, the right to object to processing, and the right to data portability.
7. The data will be processed for the duration of the competition "DINOSAURS. Still alive?", and afterwards for a period of time as required by archiving regulations.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data, if you consider that the Controller's processing of your personal data violates data protection regulations.
9. The provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary for participation in the competition.
10. Data will not be processed by automated means, including profiling.
